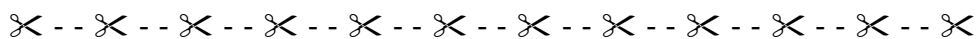


*“O LORD, how innumerable are Thy works! In wisdom Thou hast made them all!

We’ll also participate in games and activities to reinforce what we learn about the sea.
