**Creation Adventures by Science Partners**

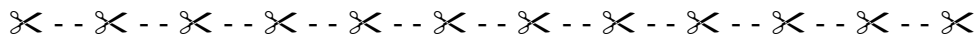


**“O LORD, how innumerable are Thy works! In wisdom Thou hast made them all!

Join Bill and Merilee Clifton - creationists, Florida Master Naturalists, homeschool science educators, and authors - as we explore the sea from a creationist perspective. Can a male sea animal give birth? Are there fish that actually have their own lighting systems? What sea animal has eyes as big as soccer balls? Bill Clifton draws from his years of experience as head of SeaWorld’s Education Department in Florida and his biblical worldview to answer these and many other questions as he shares with us his knowledge of the sea and the awesome creatures that live in it. We’ll view a fascinating visual presentation and see many artifacts from the sea including a whale rib, shark teeth and jaw, piranha, puffer fish, and more. We’ll also participate in a game and crafts to reinforce what we learn about the sea.
