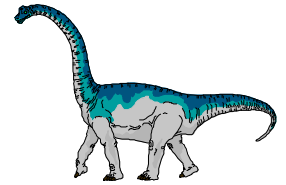




# Day of the Dinosaurs

Join Bill and Merilee Clifton - creationists, authors, Florida Master Naturalists, and science educators – as we journey back in time to the days when dinosaurs walked with man. At Dinosaur World, the world’s largest dinosaur attraction, we will see over 150 life-sized models of dinosaurs representing more than 60 species. This lush, shaded semi-tropical setting also has a small museum, an outdoor classroom, and an awesome gift shop. We will spend the morning with the dinosaurs, learn how they are named, find out about dinosaurs in the Bible, and even see real fossils! Be sure to bring your camera for some great photo opportunities! After lunch, we will travel to a phosphate museum where we can see how the worldwide flood affected Florida’s past by fossilizing the remains of sea and land animals and plants. Be sure to bring along a small spade. We will spend time digging for shark teeth and other small fossils outside the phosphate museum! You may keep everything you find!

**We will meet between 9:30 and 9:45 AM in Dinosaur World’s parking lot, 5145 Harvey Tew Road, Plant City, FL 33565.** Use [www.mapquest.com](http://www.mapquest.com) or [www.randmcnally.com](http://www.randmcnally.com) for directions and driving time from your home. Our day as a group will end at the phosphate museum around 3:30 P.M. **Be sure to bring a picnic lunch, as well as a spade or large spoon for fossil digging.** The Cliftons will provide sifting baskets and fossil ID charts. It’s always a good idea to bring sunscreen, insect repellent, water, rain poncho, and camera. Creation resources will be available for purchase during our lunch time.
