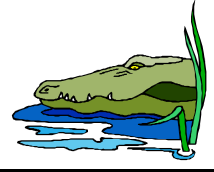




# CREATIONIST GUIDE TO SILVER SPRINGS

Creation Adventures by Science Partners

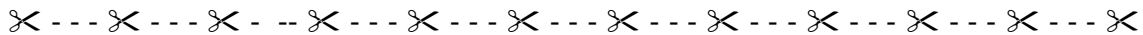

Come along with Bill and Merilee Clifton - creationists, authors, Florida Master Naturalists, and science educators - as we look for evidence of our Creator at Silver Springs, “Nature’s Theme Park.” See for yourself why countless movies and TV shows have been filmed there in one of the most beautiful wetlands and clear-water springs in the world! Aboard the world-famous Glass Bottom Boats, we’ll view the abundant Florida wildlife of the Silver River Ecosystem including fish, turtles, alligators, and birds, not to mention the largest artesian spring on the planet! At Live Animal Shows, we’ll learn more about alligators, turtles, snakes, and other creatures. We’ll also observe the endangered Florida panther, rare species of bears, exotic crocodiles, and more in their natural habitats. We’ll see the “Wings of the Springs” Bird Program and maybe even pet a giraffe! Our day as a group will end around 3:30 PM. The park is open until 5:00 PM. You can stay and enjoy other activities such as the Lighthouse Ride, Lost River Voyage, Ft. King River Cruise, Historical Showcase, Petting Zoo, Fantastic Fountains, Endangered Species Carousel, and more.

**We will meet between 9:30 and 9:45 AM in Silver Springs’ parking lot, 5656 E. Silver Springs Blvd., Silver Springs, FL 34488.** Parking is \$7 per car. Use [www.mapquest.com](http://www.mapquest.com) or [www.randmcnally.com](http://www.randmcnally.com) for directions and approximate driving time from your home. Silver Springs is approximately 1½ hours from the Orlando area. It may be more or less, depending on where you live. Except for bottled water, no outside food or beverages may be brought into the park. **Be sure to bring a picnic lunch.** We will eat as a group in the picnic area during our lunch break. It’s always a good idea to bring sunscreen, insect repellent, water, rain poncho, and camera. Creation resources will be available for purchase.
