## 2008-2009 Class Supplies



### Class Supplies – Notebook Instructions

Please read this information carefully, even if you have been in science classes before. Some of our supply requirements have changed for the students' benefit. Make sure you have the items listed below for the appropriate grade level. Then follow these instructions to put together a science notebook that will be used during the year to hold labs, quizzes, and other communications from Science Partners. When the notebook is set up correctly, all supplies needed for class are together in one place and ready to go. At the end of the year, the notebook will be the student's complete science portfolio.

1. **Cover Sheet:** Make a cover sheet and slip it into the front pocket/sleeve of the notebook. It should include the student's name and parent's phone number(s) in case it is lost. You may make your own or print and fill out the cover sheet below.
2. **Calendar:** The 2008-2009 Master Calendar (with reading assignments for grades 5-12) will be handed out at Open House. It also includes tuition due and quiz dates. Place it in the back pocket/sleeve of the notebook so it is easily accessible and doesn't get torn or lost inside.
3. **Zippered Pencil Pouch:** The first item inside the notebook is a zippered pencil pouch to hold student's colored pencils, two mechanical pencils, extra pencil lead, and other items required for grade level (such as compass, small metric ruler, hand-held calculator, etc.). See lists below.
4. **Notebook paper** goes behind zippered pencil pouch.
5. **Dividers:** Three for Grades 3 - Biology: *Lab Sheets, Quizzes, and Miscellaneous (or Misc.)* and 10 dividers for Marine Science: *1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10* (one for each class).

### Grades 3-4

- Three-ring notebook with clear pocket/sleeve on front (with cover sheet) and back (with calendar).
- Lined notebook paper.
- Three dividers. (*Lab Sheets, Quizzes, and Miscellaneous or Misc.*)
- Zippered pencil pouch in the notebook rings to hold the following items:
  - Colored pencils. (We do not use markers or crayons in science class.)
  - Two mechanical pencils and extra lead. (We do not use ink in science class.)
  - Compass (to draw circles).
  - Small metric ruler.
- Uniform. (See *Dress Code* information.)
- E-mail account. (Much of our communication will be by email. Student's family must have an active email account and check it daily, especially the day before class.)

### Grades 5-6

- Three-ring notebook with clear pocket/sleeve on front (with cover sheet) and back (with calendar).
- Lined notebook paper.
- Three dividers. (*Lab Sheets, Quizzes, and Miscellaneous or Misc.*)
- Zippered pencil pouch in the notebook rings to hold the following items:
  - Colored pencils. (We do not use markers or crayons in science class.)
  - Two mechanical pencils and extra lead. (We do not use ink in science class.)
  - Compass (to draw circles).
  - Small metric ruler.
  - Hand-held calculator. (It does not need to be "scientific.")
- Textbook is provided by Science Partners. *Please cover by first class and bring to each class.*
- Uniform. (See *Dress Code* information.)

### **Grades 7-8**

- Three-ring notebook with clear pocket/sleeve on front (with cover sheet) and back (with calendar).
- Lined notebook paper.
- Three dividers. (*Lab Sheets, Quizzes, and Miscellaneous or Misc.*)
- Zippered pencil pouch in the notebook rings to hold the following items:
  - Colored pencils. (*We do not use markers or crayons in science class.*)
  - Two mechanical pencils and extra lead. (*We do not use ink in science class.*)
  - Compass (to draw circles).
  - Small metric ruler.
  - Hand-held calculator. (*It does not need to be "scientific."*)
- Textbook is provided by Science Partners. *Please cover by first class and bring to each class.*
- Uniform. (See *Dress Code* information.)
- E-mail account. (Much of our communication will be by email. Student's family must have an active email account and check it daily, especially the day before class.)

### **Grades 9-12 Biology**

- Three-ring notebook with clear pocket/sleeve on front (with cover sheet) and back (with calendar).
- Lined notebook paper.
- Three dividers. (*Lab Sheets, Quizzes, and Miscellaneous or Misc.*)
- Zippered pencil pouch in the notebook rings to hold the following items:
  - Colored pencils. (*We do not use markers or crayons in science class.*)
  - Two mechanical pencils and extra lead. (*We do not use ink in science class.*)
  - Compass (to draw circles).
  - Small metric ruler.
  - Hand-held calculator. (*It does not need to be "scientific."*)
- Textbook is provided by Science Partners. *Please cover by first class and bring to each class.*
- Uniform. (See *Dress Code* information.)
- E-mail account. (Much of our communication will be by email. Student's family must have an active email account and check it daily, especially the day before class.)

### **Grades 10 -12 Marine Science at SeaWorld**

- Backpack. (SeaWorld security may search backpacks before we enter the park.)
- Three-ring notebook with clear pocket/sleeve on front (with cover sheet) and back (with calendar).
- Lined notebook paper.
- Ten dividers - one for each class. (*1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10*)
- Zippered pencil pouch in the notebook rings to hold the following items:
  - Colored pencils. (*We do not use markers or crayons in science class.*)
  - At least two mechanical pencils and extra lead. (*We do not use ink in science class.*)
- Lunch/drink for morning class; snack/drink for afternoon class. We have a full agenda and do NOT have time to wait in line to purchase food/snacks/drinks. Students will NOT be allowed to buy food/snacks/drinks during class time. There are water fountains at SeaWorld but you may want to bring extra water. It can be very hot in August, September, and May.
- SeaWorld annual pass that is good through May 2009.
- Rain poncho. (Rain showers occur often in Florida.)
- Textbook is provided by Science Partners. *Please cover by first class.* It will not be used during class time and should be left at home.
- Uniform. (See *Dress Code* information.)
- E-mail account. (Much of our communication will be by email. Student's family must have an active email account and check it daily, especially the day before class.)
