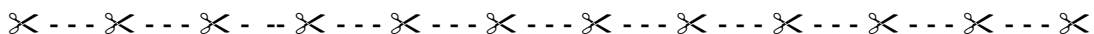

Join Bill and Merilee Clifton on a tour of St. Augustine, our nation's oldest city. Our day begins at the Fountain of Youth, a National Archaeological Park. The park is located at the site of the ancient Timucuan Indian town of Seloy. This is where the history of North America began when Ponce de Leon came ashore, placed a cross made of stones on the ground, and claimed ALL of North America for Spain. At that time, "La Florida" was the entire North American continent, not just our state! Our group will tour the Springhouse where we can sample water from the spring that Ponce de Leon thought was the Fountain of Youth. We'll also see the Ponce de Leon Landmark Cross – thought to be the actual stone cross that his men placed on the ground in 1513 - as well as Navigator's Planetarium, Timucuan Indian village, other exhibits, the grounds, and gift shop. Then we're off for Old Florida Museum. We'll eat lunch first, and then participate in Old Florida Museum's unique, "HANDS-ON" programs designed to be entertaining as well as educational. Students experience life in St. Augustine through the struggles and successes of its people during distinct time periods of Florida's history. Next, we'll head to St. Augustine's historical district where we'll visit Castillo de San Marcos. Mr. Clifton will give a short overview of the fort and then instruct the group on exploring 300 years of Florida history at this unique national monument. And, Mrs. Clifton will lead us to historic St. George Street where we'll have an opportunity to step back in time on this narrow, paved brick street to see the Oldest Wooden Schoolhouse in the USA, the City Gate, Huguenot Cemetery, and more. **Our day as a group will end at the historic district at approximately 3:30 PM.**

We will meet between 8:30 and 8:45 AM at the Fountain of Youth parking lot, 11 Magnolia Avenue in St. Augustine. Use www.mapquest.com or www.randmcnally.com for directions from your home. Driving directions for the rest of the day will be provided. **Be sure to bring a picnic lunch.** It's always a good idea to bring sunscreen, insect repellent, water, rain poncho, and camera.
