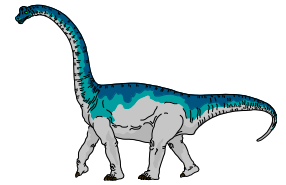




Day of the Dinosaurs

Join Bill and Merilee Clifton - creationists, authors, Florida Master Naturalists, and science educators – as we journey back in time to the days when dinosaurs walked with man. At Dinosaur World, the world’s largest dinosaur attraction, we will see over 200 life-sized models of dinosaurs representing more than 60 species. This lush, shaded semi-tropical setting also has a museum and an awesome gift shop. We will spend the morning with the dinosaurs, find out if dinosaurs are mentioned in the Bible, learn how fossils are made, and even see real fossils and a scale model of Noah’s ark! Be sure to bring your camera for some great photo opportunities! After lunch, we will travel to a phosphate museum where we can see how the worldwide flood affected Florida’s past by fossilizing the remains of sea and land animals and plants. Be sure to bring along a small spade, if you have one. We will spend time digging for shark teeth and a variety of other small fossils outside the phosphate museum! You may keep everything you find!

We will meet between 9:30 and 9:45 AM in Dinosaur World’s parking lot, 5145 Harvey Tew Road, Plant City, FL 33565. For directions and time to allow from your home, check www.googlemaps.com or www.mapquest.com. Our day as a group will end at the phosphate museum around 3:30 PM. **Be sure to bring a picnic lunch, as well as a spade or large spoon for fossil digging.** The Cliftons will provide and sifting baskets and fossil ID charts, as well as extra spades if you don’t have any. It’s always a good idea to bring sunscreen, insect repellent, water, rain poncho, and camera. Creation resources will be available for purchase during our digging time at the museum.
