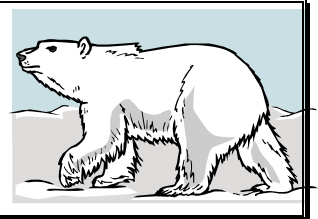


The Bear Essentials

What is a bear? Where do bears live around the world? Could they be living in your neighborhood? Join Bill and Merilee Clifton – creationists, authors, Florida Master Naturalists, and science educators – as we look at the major bear species of the world in general and then focus on our own Florida Black Bear. This bear is our state’s largest land mammal and, sadly, is on Florida’s threatened species list. Through a variety of activities, we will learn bear anatomy and physiology, behavior, seasonal activities and movement, life cycles, habitat requirements, and limiting factors. We’ll see bear skulls, claws, tracks, fur, and scat (what’s that?!), as well as learn ecological concepts to help us understand how our actions impact the Florida Black Bear’s survival. Learn to “Be Bear Aware.”
