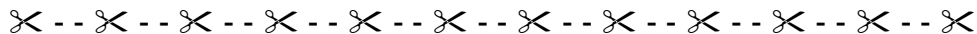
Creation Adventures by Science Partners

Can a male sea animal give birth? Are there fish that actually have their own lighting systems? What sea animal has eyes as big as soccer balls? Mr. Bill Clifton, creationist, author, Florida Master Naturalist, and science educator, draws from his years of experience as head of SeaWorld Orlando’s Education Department and his creationist perspective to answer these and other questions as he shares with us his knowledge of the sea and the awesome creatures that live in it. We’ll view a fascinating visual presentation and see many artifacts from the sea including a whale rib, shark teeth and jaw, puffer fish, and more. We’ll also participate in a game and crafts to reinforce what we learn about the sea.
